Hope Nottingham has been distributing c10,000 emergency food parcels per year, supporting local people in crisis. In partnership with Trussell, we are working to end the need for foodbanks and are now looking for a special person to enhance the development of our foodbank offer.

Key responsibilities of the role will include:

- Identifying barriers faced by our guests
- Reviewing and analysing our current foodbank offer and usage in conjunction with other key foodbank staff and our volunteer teams
- Researching and mapping local services
- Exploring potential development areas to enhance services to foodbank guests
- Supporting the development and implementation of our 'community café' model across our foodbanks
- Developing and leading on projects such as Digital Inclusion, Money Coaching and more
- Supporting the skills development and training of our foodbank volunteer teams
- Helping us develop our approach to campaigning to end the need for foodbanks, contributing to social media and marketing
